Material Fact

COSAN S.A. INDÚSTRIA E COMÉRCIO ("Company" or "Cosan") (BM&FBOVESPA: CSAN3), announces to its shareholders and the market in general that Raízen Combustíveis S.A., joint venture between Cosan and Shell, acquired 10% of the shares representative of the capital stock of STP - Serviços e Tecnologia de Pagamentos S.A. (STP) from CCR, Ivan Toledo de Corrêa Filho, EcoRodovias and GSMP for the total amount of R\$ 250,000,000.00 (two hundred and fifty million reais).

With the acquisition, the companies will work together to develop an automatic payment system to the Shell branded service stations. Raízen is the licensee of the Shell brand in Brazil and will maintain seats on STP's Board of Directors and Fiscal Council.

The closing of the transaction is subject to the fulfillment of certain precedent conditions, including the necessary approval from the Conselho Administrativo de Defesa Econômica – CADE, the Brazilian antitrust authority.

STP is the company operating the "Sem Parar" and "Via Fácil" automatic payment systems in Brazil. With 4 million users, "Sem Parar" is currently present in 54 highway concessionaires and 167 parking lots at airports and shopping malls nationwide, in the states of São Paulo, Rio de Janeiro, Paraná, Minas Gerais, Bahia, Mato Grosso, Mato Grosso do Sul, Santa Catarina and Rio Grande do Sul. CCR, CCBR Catel, EcoRodovias, GSMP and Arteris are STP's shareholders.
